Th, 2/8	Enrollment frozen (FCC) Outreach grants frozen (FCC)*
Th, 2/29*	End date announced (FCC)
Fr, 3/1*	Govt. shutdown deadline (Congress)
Fr, 3/15*	Second consumer notification (ISPs)
Mo, 4/1*	Third and final consumer notification (ISPs)
We, 5/1*	Full ACP benefit ends
Sa, 6/1*	Partial ACP benefit ends

Notes

By "end date," the FCC means the last month during which the ACP can afford to pay the full benefit to all enrollees.

Consumer notifications 2, 3 will say:

- (1) that the ACP is ending,
- (2) the impact on consumers' bills,
- (3) the date of the last discounted bill,
- (4) that the consumer may change their service or opt-out of continuing service after the end of the ACP

*Not official. Estimates based on April end date.
